

Fall Vintage Rifle Match

Springfield Rifle - Military Vintage Bolt Rifle - J. C. Garand Vintage Military Sniper - Unlimited Garand – Carbine/Fun Match

Saturday, November 21, 2015

This is a fun match organized to make it easy even for the first timer to participate!

River Bend Gun Club is hosting sanctioned CMP Games matches including: J.C. Garand; Springfield Rifle; Military Vintage Bolt Rifle Match; and Unlimited Garand Matches. Plus our own non-sanctioned Vintage Military Sniper and Carbine Fun match on Saturday, November 21, 2015. Be there by 08:15am, firing will begin promptly at 9am. Match fee is \$15 (non-RBGC members); \$10 RBGC members; \$5 Juniors (20 and under). Awards will be CMP Achievement pins for participants who shoot a qualifying score in the CMP sanctioned Games matches.

Participants must provide their own ammunition (minimum 55 rounds). All matches will be shot concurrently; you can only participate in one of the matches listed. RBGC has target pits - all participants are required to perform pit duty.

Eligibility:

You do not need to be a GSSA or RBGC member to participate. Competition in CMP sanctioned matches is open to anyone who is a citizen of the United States.

Course of Fire -

Minimum of 55 rounds of ammunition required, participants must provide their own ammunition.

Stage 1 - Slow fire, prone, maximum of 5 sighting shots followed by 20 record shots, time limit of 25 minutes. Shooter must inform scorekeeper before starting record shots. (SR Target)

Stage 2 - Rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 80 seconds. (SR Target)

Stage 3 - Rapid fire, sitting from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 70 seconds. (SR Target)

Stage 4 - (JCG, SPR, MVB, UGM, CFM) Slow fire, standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 10 min. (SR Tgt.)

Stage 4 – (VMS only) Prone Rapid Fire, 10 record shots, while moving IDPA silhouettes are exposed.

Rifles Permitted: *Please refer to CMP Competition Rules and Regulations for detail specifications.*

J.C. Garand match (JCG):

- As issued U.S. rifle, caliber .30, M1 Garand in "as issued" configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights.

Springfield Match (SPR):

- As issued U.S. rifle, caliber .30, M1903 Springfield (except low-numbered) or 1903A3 in "as issued" configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights.

Military Vintage Bolt Rifle Match (MVB):

- Any non-US Military Bolt action military rifle of the type used during the WWII era in "as issued" configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights.
- The caliber .30 M1917 Enfield or U.S. Krag Rifle in original "as issued" configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights.

Unlimited Garand (UGM):

- U.S. rifle, caliber .30, M1 Garand that has been modified or accurized to include different calibers, sights, glass bedding, synthetic stocks, etc... Iron sights only. Per CMP rules must not weigh more than 10.5 lbs.

Vintage Military Sniper Rifle Match (VMS) Not CMP Sanctioned - an Individual event, not teams.

- Any original or replica sniper rifle of the type issued to troops during the WWII era – US or Foreign.
- Rifles must be scoped. Scopes and mounts must be the type issued with the original sniper rifles.
- Same COF except: 1) Stage 4 as noted above and 2) an additional 10 seconds during rapid fire.
- Any GI field gear (pack, bag etc...) may be used as a rest in all prone stages, not other rests allowed.

Carbine/Fun Match (CFM – Not CMP Sanctioned):

- M1 Carbines or any other rifle (bolt or semi-auto) of the types issued during WWII.
- Rifles are not required to be "as issue", can modified to improve accuracy or be a non-issued caliber.
