

2010 Georgia State High Power Rifle and EIC Match

The 2010 Georgia State High Power Rifle and EIC Match, sponsored by River Bend Gun Club, will be held June 12th and 13th at River Bend Gun Club.

River Bend Gun Club, Dawson Co., GA. River Bend Gun Club is located north of Atlanta in the southeast corner of Dawson County, approximately one hour drive from Atlanta. From the north side of I-285 take GA 400 to intersection of State 369. Go 12.3 miles to Yellow Creek Road. Turn right and go 4.5 miles to Shiloh Church Road. Turn right and go 0.3 miles to paved fork; bear right to gravel county road to the gun club—1.25 miles.

Eligibility: Open to all shooters. Georgia competitors must be a current member of GSSA to be eligible for the award “state champion”.

Entries: Limited to 100 competitors.

Entry closing date: No preregistration.

Entry Fees: 6/12/2010-- \$30 which includes NRA and GSSA fees.

6/13/2010-- \$20 which includes NRA and CMP fees.

Awards, Categories, Classes, & Classification: The NRA classification system will be used with a minimum of five entries need to establish a class. Unclassified shooters will compete in the master class. Appropriate NRA award points will be given to the open winner and all class winners; first place for five or more entrants in a class, second for eight or more, and third place for eleven or more in a class. Note: A “High Power State Championship” will be awarded 6/12.

Rules: Current NRA High Power rules will govern throughout.

Current CMP rules will govern the EIC Match.

Rifles & Ammunition: 6/12—Rifles allowed 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.3. & 3.3.1

Competitors will furnish their own ammunition.

Targets: SR at 200 yards; SR-3 at 300 yards; MR-1 at 600 yards.

Target Service and Scoring: Competitors will be required to operate targets, provide pit service and score for other competitors.

Challenges: A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge.

Facilities: Bring your food and drinks.

Match schedule: Saturday June 12, 2010, 8:30 am local time. Individual match.

Match 1 -- 200 yard Slow Fire Standing – 2 sighters plus 20 rounds for record with a time limit of 22 minutes – SR target.

Match 2 -- 200 yards Rapid Fire Sitting– 2 sighters plus 2 – 10 shot strings, 60 seconds per string – SR target.

Match 3 -- 300 yards Rapid Fire Prone– 2 sighters plus 2 – 10 shot strings, 70 seconds per string – SR-3 target.

Match 4 – 600 yards Slow Fire Prone – 2 sighters plus 20 rounds for record with a time limit of 22 minutes – MR-1 target

Match 5 – Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, & 4.

CMP: EIC Service Rifle and Directors Match

Time: Trigger weigh will begin at 0800 and closes at 0845. Firing begins at 0900.

Entry fee: \$20 Cash only

Eligibility: CMP Rules 4.1, 4.6.2, 4.6.3 apply.

Course of fire: The National Match Course, 50 shot, no sighting shots. CMP Rule 9.9 Both strings of 200 will be fired in succession. All competitors must score and pull pits.

Awards: All awards in the EIC match will be issued by the CMP. Rule 10.12.5

Rifles: EIC match - U.S. M1 Rifle; or U.S. M1 Rifle 7.62; U.S. M14 Rifle; or U.S. M16 Rifle or their commercial equivalent.

Scoring: All scoring will be in ink, scorecards will be correct and complete before submitted.

Judges: Judges will be named at the beginning of the match, decision of the judges is final. Judges reserve the right to weigh medalists' triggers.

Match schedule: Sunday June 13, 2009, 9:00 am local time. EIC Match.

Match 1 -- 200 yard Slow Fire Standing – 10 rounds for record with a time limit of 10 minutes – SR target.

Match 2 -- 200 yards Rapid Fire Sitting from Standing – 1 – 10 shot strings, 60 seconds per string – SR target.

Match 3 -- 300 yards Rapid Fire Prone from Standing – 1 – 10 shot strings, 70 seconds per string – SR-3 target.

Match 4 – 600 yards Slow Fire Prone – 20 rounds for record with a time limit of 22 minutes – MR-1 target

Match 5 – Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, & 4.
